



OSL School Scholarships & Discounts 2024-2025

Descriptions of scholarships and discounts approved by the Executive Leadership team. All students receiving financial aid in the form of a discount or scholarship must have a letter on file. Scholarships are renewable, unless indicated otherwise. Scholarships may not exceed \$18,500 (full scholarship).

Academic Scholarships

1) Falcon Scholarship

\$1,000-\$6,000 annually

Students receiving the Falcon Scholarship must demonstrate academic achievement, either at their previous school (90 average or better) or on a qualifying test for entry to Our Saviour Lutheran. The scholarship is renewable, pending student and family commitment. To remain qualified, students agree to maintain: 1) an average 85% or better; 2) excellent attendance; 3) a record with minimal disciplinary infractions.

Athletic Scholarships

1) Gold Athletic Scholarship (*Full*)

\$13,800 annually

Students receiving the Gold Athletic Scholarship have their full tuition covered after demonstrating their athletic ability, subject to the approval of the Director of Programs & Athletic Director. To remain qualified, students agree to maintain: 1) an average 75% or better; 2) excellent attendance; 3) a record with minimal disciplinary infractions.

2) Maroon Athletic Scholarship (*Partial*)

\$1,000-\$7,000 annually

Students receiving the Maroon Athletic Scholarship have their tuition covered after demonstrating their athletic ability, subject to the approval of the Director of Programs & Athletic Director. To remain qualified, students agree to maintain: 1) an average 75% or better; 2) excellent attendance; 3) a record with minimal disciplinary infractions.

Merit-Based Scholarships

1) City to Come Scholarship

\$1,000-\$9,000 annually

Students receiving the City to Come Scholarship demonstrate a desire to be a change maker and leader in their school, church, family, and wider communities through an essay or video submission. Students must demonstrate residency in either a borough of NYC or a city/urban area. To remain qualified, students agree to maintain: 1) an average of 75% or better; 2) excellent attendance; 3) church & community service; 4) a record with minimal disciplinary infractions.

2) Artistic Endeavors Scholarship

\$1,000-\$6,000 annually

Students receiving the Artistic Endeavors Scholarship demonstrate artistic aptitude in the areas of performing or visual arts. Students are required to submit samples to be approved by art faculty and the Executive Leadership team. To remain qualified, students agree to maintain: 1) an average of 80% or better; 2) excellent attendance; 3) a record with minimal disciplinary infractions. Additionally, students are required to be active participants in the program area related to their scholarship and to produce work for use in the wider OSL community.

3) Women of Initiative Scholarship

\$1,000-\$6,000 annually

This scholarship is open to female students in their 1st year at OSL. Students receiving the Women of Initiative Scholarship demonstrate their commitment to improving the lives of girls/young women, and have leadership qualities that others have identified in them. To remain qualified, students agree to maintain: 1) an average of 80% or better; 2) excellent attendance; 3) a record with minimal disciplinary infractions. Additionally, students are required to be active participants in YWOW and to serve as ambassadors at OSL sponsored events.

4) Rev. George Ramsudh Scholarship

\$1,000-\$6,000 annually

Students receiving the Rev. George Ramsudh Scholarship must demonstrate their commitment to lives of Christian service, have leadership qualities that others have identified in them, and be dedicated to sharing their Christian Faith as a part of every vocation in their lives. To remain qualified, students agree to maintain: 1) an average of 80% or better; 2) excellent attendance; 3) a record with minimal disciplinary infractions. Additionally, students are required to be active participants in our Christian worship life, including maintaining a connection with our supporting congregations, and to serve as ambassadors at OSL sponsored events.

Approval-Based Discounts

1) Sibling Discount

\$500-\$3,500 annually

The sibling discount is available to students who have a biological or adopted sibling currently enrolled at OSL in the 8-12 grade or postgraduate program. Siblings must attend OSL concurrently and the scholarship for the youngest sibling is effective to graduation date. Students must maintain passing grades, consistent attendance, and be in good disciplinary standing.

2) Alumni Discount

\$500-\$3,500 annually

The alumni discount is available to students who have a direct connection to an alumni of OSL. The student is required to submit an essay and the alumni is required to provide a recommendation letter. Students must maintain passing grades, consistent attendance, and be in good disciplinary standing. Students and families are required to assist at OSL sponsored events (3-5 annually).

3) Educator Discount

\$500-\$3,000 annually

The educator discount is available to students who have a direct connection to a current educator at OSL. Students are recommended by faculty/staff and are required to maintain passing grades, consistent attendance, and remain in good disciplinary standing. Students and families are required to assist at OSL sponsored events (3-5 annually).
